Our work focuses on bridging gaps in education, healthcare, economic empowerment, and environmental sustainability, particularly in informal settlements and marginalized rural communities.

We operate with the conviction that long-term change is achieved not through short-term aid, but through empowering communities to become active participants in their own development.

OUR STORY

UCESCO-Africa was founded in 2010 following a grassroots intervention in Rwanda that demonstrated the power of targeted, dignity-centered support. What began as a single household empowerment initiative revealed a deeper truth: strategic, community-rooted action can generate lasting change far beyond immediate relief.

Building on this philosophy, UCESCO-Africa expanded its operations into Kenya and Uganda, focusing on underserved urban settlements and rural communities. Today, the organization maintains an active presence across **Nairobi** (Kibera, Mathare), **Samburu County, Mombasa**, and partner communities in **Uganda**, supported by international partnerships and a growing global volunteer network.





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COMMUNITY CONTEXT & RATIONALE

UNDERSTANDING THE COMMUNITIES WE SERVE

UCESCO-Africa works in regions characterized by high poverty levels, limited public services, and systemic exclusion. In informal settlements such as Kibera and Mathare, families face overlapping challenges including poor access to healthcare, overcrowded learning environments, food insecurity, and unemployment.

Rather than approaching these challenges in isolation, we adopt an integrated development model that addresses root causes while strengthening local systems and leadership.

Within these challenges lie strong community networks and resilience that form the foundation of our work.

A. Education & Talent Development

Education is the foundation of social mobility and community resilience. UCESCO-Africa supports access to quality education through:

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE


including classroom construction, libraries, and computer labs

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B. Vocational Training & Youth Skills (MVETI)

Through the Masayo Vocational Education and Training Institute (MVETI), UCESCO equips youth and women with marketable skills in **beauty therapy, tailoring, digital skills**, and **entrepreneurship**. The program prioritizes young mothers and marginalized women, linking skills training to **income generation** and **self-reliance**.



C. Economic Empowerment & Agriculture

We strengthen household resilience through:

Sustainable Agriculture

Sustainable agriculture initiatives, including eco-farming and school gardens

Women's Livelihoods

Women-led microbusiness development in retail, agriculture, and crafts

Environmental Stewardship

Environmental conservation through large-scale tree planting and community clean-ups





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D. YOUTH, SPORTS & SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

We engage young people through structured programs that promote wellbeing, talent development, and positive social participation.

Key focus areas:


- Youth mentorship, leadership development, and life-skills training
- Sports, arts, and creative programs that foster confidence and teamwork
- Safe spaces for social engagement, inclusion, and personal growth

E. HEALTH, SANITATION & NUTRITION

UCESCO-Africa delivers community-based healthcare through:

- **Free Medical Camps** providing general, specialized, and preventive care
- **Mini medical outreaches** in remote and underserved locations
- **Health education on nutrition**, maternal health, and disease prevention
- **School feeding programs** supporting child development and learning outcomes

These interventions are implemented in collaboration with licensed medical professionals, county health systems, and trained volunteers.
