| \$60 / €55 one-time | Buys a startup kit (sewing/hairdressing): Sponsor gets photo of recipient with their kit, one meal provided to the student, thank-you message, digital recognition on website. |
| \$180 / €165– Full Course Sponsorship | Full course sponsorship for one student: Sponsor gets student profile with photo, course updates, one meal provided to the student, digital recognition on website, donation receipt. |




Before MVETI, I had nothing but a dream and two children to feed. As a single mother from a humble background, life in Kibera was about survival.
